'Flemish Illuminated Manuscripts' – Dr Scot McKendrick

Monthly meeting on Tuesday 13th February, Desborough Bowling Club at 2.30 pm

This talk by a distinguished former curator at the British Library will introduce the less familiar illuminated manuscripts that offer some of the best evidence for our understanding of early Netherlandish painting between 1400 and 1550.

Dr Scot McKendrick was formerly Head of Western Heritage Collections at the British Library, where he had charge of western manuscripts, archives, rare books, music and maps.
